## Goals

- **Knowledge Base:** Demonstrate knowledge of core areas of psychological science as well as the ability to interpret and apply knowledge of psychological science
- Scientific Literacy and Critical Thinking: Demonstrate the ability to reason scientifically, understand scientific research, understand basic statistics relevant to behavioral sciences and think critically.
- Ethical and Social Responsibility in a Diverse World: Demonstrate a basic understanding of ethical principles as they apply to psychological research and practice.
- Communication: Demonstrate an ability to communicate effectively in written and oral presentations.
- **Professional Development:** Demonstrate the ability to apply skills learned to enhance teamwork, career preparation, and manage projects in a work or educational environment.

## Methodology

- Graduating Senior Psychology Majors completed survey (N=75)
- For each goal, provided a set of statements
  - 5 point scale ranging from strongly disagree to strongly agree
  - Half of all items for each student were negatively framed and half positively framed, counterbalanced across students
    - My classes and experiences as a psychology major prepared me to describe key concepts, principles, and overarching themes in psychology
    - My classes and experiences as a psychology major failed to prepare me to describe key concepts, principles, and overarching themes in psychology
  - Negatively framed items reverse coded; for ease of exposition, positively framed version of each item shown in the following results
  - For each item, we calculated percent agreeing with the positive frame -- or disagreeing with negative frame
  - We also calculated mean on a 5 point scale

Goal 1. Knowledge Base: Demonstrate knowledge of core areas of psychological science as well as the ability to interpret and apply knowledge of psychological science
