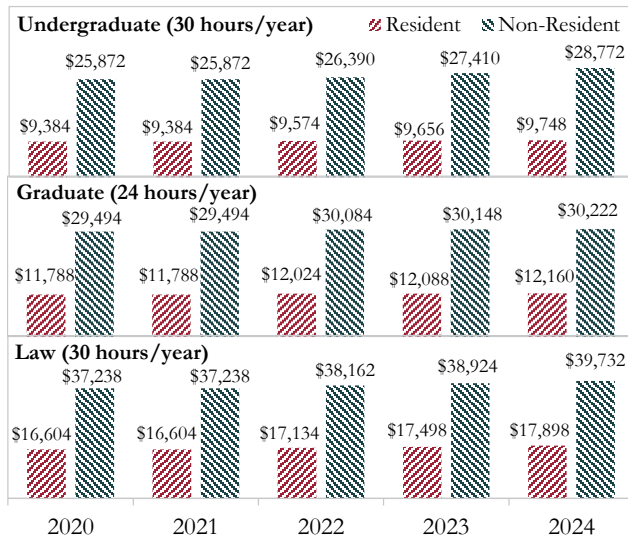


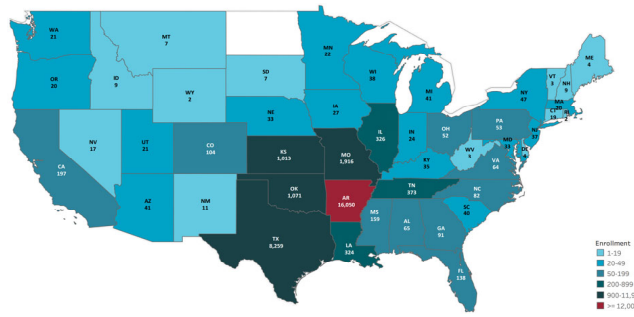

Enrollment By Legal Residence State



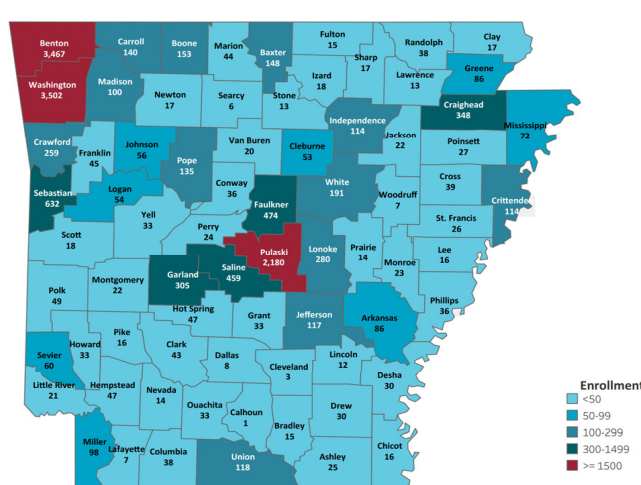

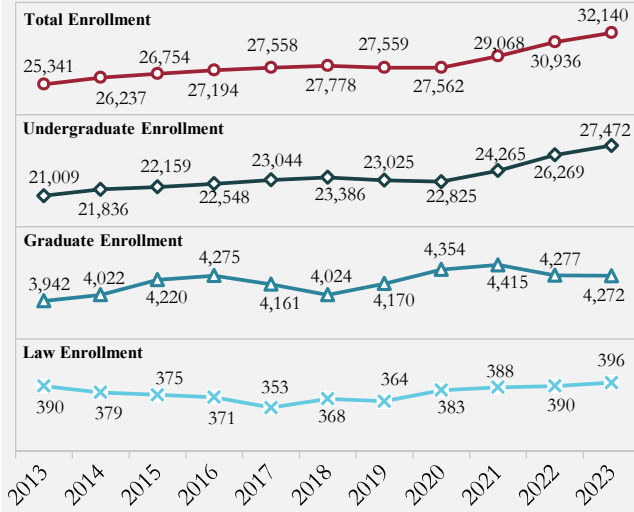

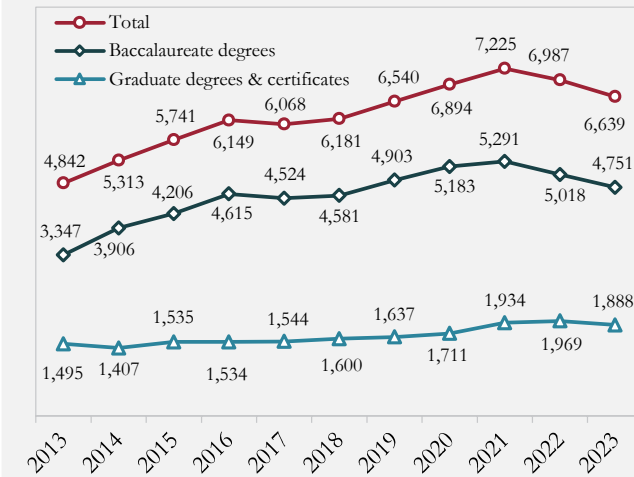

Enrollment Trends



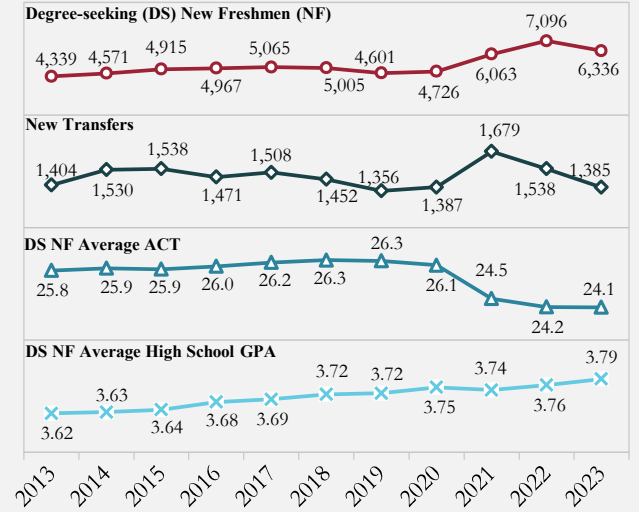

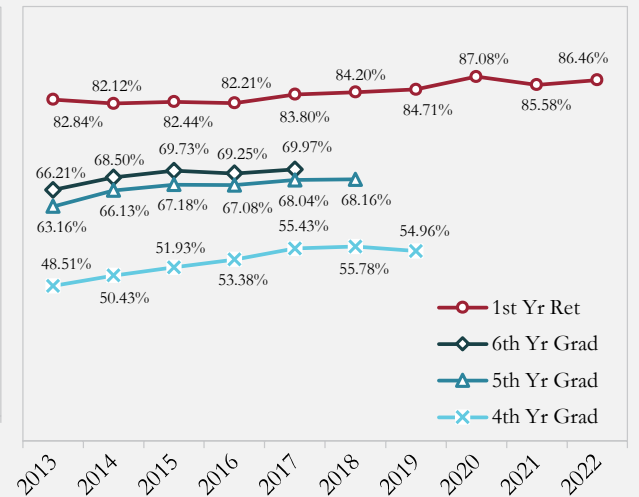
